LAST BRUSH PICK-UP: September 15, 2010 will be the last day for brush pick-up in the Village of Honeoye Falls due to the impending fall season and the onset of leaf pick-up. Please have brush to the curb by September 15. Brush pick-up will resume in the spring of 2011.

LEAF PICK-UP: will begin in October. Our equipment is not changed over to handle leaf pick up before this date. If you have leaves to dispose of, bring them to the Village compost pile at the DPW facility. The Village of Honeoye Falls will continue our practice of vacuuming leaves during the fall season as we have done for many years. Leaves should be raked to the roadside.
