The Town & Village of Lima and the Village of Honeoye Falls are happy to announce that a "Shared Services" agreement has been created and approved to utilize Mr. Charlie Johnson as (building inspector) for all three municipalities. This agreement was created due to the retirement of Mr. Paul Luft who served as Lima 's Code Enforcement Officer and handled these duties prior.

This action will benefit all three municipalities and shows a positive working agreement that is multi-jurisdictional. In this capacity, Mr. Johnson, a New York State licensed architect and Lima resident, will work 25 hours per week for the Village of Honeoye Falls and 10 hours each for the Town and Village of Lima. Mr. Johnson currently serves as the Village of Honeoye Falls building inspector which includes duties of code enforcement and fire inspections as well. These same duties will be provided for Lima and Honeoye Falls under this new agreement.

In a joint statement, Supervisor Pete Yendell, and Mayors Carl Luft and Rick Milne wrote: "We believe that Charlie Johnson will bring high standards of professionalism and customer service that will serve our municipalities well. We are happy to create this shared services agreement and appreciate the support of our respective town and village boards in this endeavor. This is a positive action that is good representation of shared services efforts in our communities."
