Honeoye Falls Village Residents,

The following information is to help support those of you that have sustained damage to your property from yesterday's storm.

The Village of Honeoye Falls will expand its normal brush pick-up limits and will arrange to pick up any limbs, branches and tree parts that fell due to the storm. While we (normally) will not pick up items larger than 4" in diameter, in an effort to support we will pick up whatever tree debris you are able to get curbside. Please ask those companies that may be working on your property or if you are cutting items yourself, to try to cut the limbs or branches to 6' foot lengths or less and cut any tree trunk pieces to 24" in length. Your help with this is appreciated.

We will continue this expanded pick-up for the next two weeks or so as we certainly understand that clean-up will take some time. If you have specific questions regarding this, please contact the Village Office at (624-1711) and they will direct your call or question to the appropriate person.

We appreciate your patience and support through this emergency and thank you for supporting your community.
