**WORKSHOP**

The Board met at 7:35 p.m. to continue discussing Light Industrial West Main St. zoning, using legislation from the Town of Ogden as a basis, with input from Victor and Penfield legislation.

Board members discussed the pros and cons of 1 row parking in front of buildings, along with landscaping; parking in front versus front and side parking, as well as side and rear parking. A consensus was reached to allow only side and rear (back) parking, with no front parking.

Additionally, it was agreed to rezone the IP District on West Main Street to Light Industrial Zoning.

The Board completed their proposed changes to the West Main St. zoning. Legislation will be created as per their suggestions, presented to the Village Board of Trustees and subsequently back to the Planning Board once finally approved and re-written.

The clerk was asked to check on two items:

1. Check on the old Gleason parcels get tax numbers and find out what, if any, have been subdivided. Also which parcels are now owned by the Mendon Foundation.
2. Copies of the new Fence Legislation to be copied and mailed to both the Planning and Zoning Boards.

This workshop was adjourned at 9:30 p.m.
