**PUBLIC HEARING : SITE PLAN REVIEW : DEMOLITION: 255 NORTH MAIN STREET:

Mr. Hoffman and the Board reviewed comments from Chairman Heischman regarding the application.

Mr. Sean O'Mara, son-in-law of the applicant, approached the Board to discuss Mr. Jacob's plan to demolish the house located on a 72 acre parcel of land. Mr. O'Mara presented a letter from the applicant which requested the Board approve the application to demolish the house and shed which had fallen into a state of disrepair. Mr. Jacobs stated in his letter that the house had no historical value, was considered to be dangerous, and was considered to be an eyesore to the neighborhood.
