Dear Charlie:

We request an administrative change for the relocation of the existing light pole, as discussed with the contractor. We proposed the following changes.

1. Leave the light pole in its current location.
2. Leave the concrete "barrel" on the north end of the island.
3. Leave approximately three feet of the island, south of the light pole, and form a new curb. The remainder of the island, planters and railings will be removed.
4. Paint the concrete curb and barrel yellow.
5. Fill the void, after the island is removed, with asphalt paving to match the existing.
6. The site plan will be revised, and will be resubmitted.

This light pole is directly in line with the others in the parking lot. We believe these changes will not adversely affect the traffic safety, and will actual increase the visibility of the light pole.
