- REGULAR MEETING:** The Regular Meeting of the Village of Honeoye Falls Board of Trustees was called to order by Deputy Mayor Pavelsky at 7:00 p.m. with the Pledge.

- MINUTES:** Resolution by Trustee Stottler, seconded by Trustee Alfieri to approve minutes of June 15, 2015. Motion carried.
- YEAR END ABSTRACT:** Motion by Trustee Worboys, seconded by Trustee Alfieri to approve Final TransferS for 2014 – 2015 Budget year.
- ABSTRACT No. 2:** Motion by Trustee Pavelsky, seconded by Trustee Worboys that upon an audit of Abstract No.2 of 2015/2016 that approval be given for payment of the General Fund in the amount of \$65,963.78; Sewer Fund in the amount of \$9,812.46 to include vouchers #142226 – 142285; 14300 - 14326.
